

Vision for Victory

It is easy to sit and constantly analyze the problem along with the mass media. The winners however look for a solution. It is the difference between being an over-developed survivor or a developed achiever.

This discussion presents a five-step system of first creating a vision of what you want to accomplish. Next we discuss techniques on how to make the vision clear and keep that vision in front of them daily. Next the participant is taught to remove the thoughts in their head that are keeping them from achieving their vision which is called mental clutter. The third step is to develop and stay on a concrete process and techniques are shown so the participant does not vary. And finally, we discuss how to recognize and seize opportunities that enable the vision to be realized which we call "claiming it."




Madison Park, A Place of Hope

Motley will provide a thoughtful reflection of how faith and radical love within a tight-knit community can significantly impact a person's life.



CANCELLATION POLICY — Due to very strict cancellation policies and prepayment policies imposed on ABA by third party providers, the following cancellation policy is necessary and will apply. ABA will process a \$150 per person administrative fee for all cancellations, regardless of when they are received. Cancellations received in writing by May 1, 2019 are eligible to receive a refund (minus the \$150

per person administrative fee). No refunds can be offered after 5 p.m. on May 1, 2019 although substitutions are always welcome.

TAX DEDUCTION — If the purpose of attending the ABA Annual Convention is to help you maintain or improve skills relating to employment or business, expenses relating to the conference may be tax deductible according to I.R.C. Reg 1.162-5. Consult your tax advisor. The IRS requires a notice on all registration forms which informs the attendee of the amount of the registration fee representing food and beverage. We estimate that the food cost portion of your basic registration fee is \$600 per person. Please contact your accountant or tax advisor for any tax advice.
